Quakers in the Israeli Palestinian Conflict Nancy Gallagher, 2007-09-01 The Israeli Palestinian conflict has resulted in the longest-standing refugee crisis in the world today. As Slater reexamines the entire history of the conflict from its onset at the end of WWI through the Netanyahu era, he argues that a refutation of the many mythologies that is a necessary first step toward solving the Arab-Israeli conflict. Focusing on both the US role in the conflict and Israel's actions, this book exposes the self-defeating policies of both nations — policies which have only served to prolong the conflict far beyond when it should have been resolved.
