Entranced Earth Jens Andermann, 2023-05-15 A sweeping analysis of the lasting effects of neocolonial extractivism in Latin American aesthetic modernity from 1920 to the present Looking to the extractive frontier as a focal point of Latin American art, literature, music, and film, Jens Andermann asks what emerges at the other end of landscape. Art in the Global South has long represented and interrogated “insurgent nature”—organic and inorganic matter, human and nonhuman life, thrown into turmoil. In *Entranced Earth: Art, Extractivism, and the End of Landscape*, Andermann traces the impact of despaïsamiento—world-destroying un-landscaping—throughout the Latin American modernist archive. At the same time, he explores innovative, resilient modes of allyship forged between diverse actors through their shared experiences of destruction. From the literary regionalism of the 1930s to contemporary bio art, from modernist garden architecture to representations of migration and displacement in sound art and film, *Entranced Earth* tracks the crisis of landscape and environmental exhaustion beyond despair toward speculative, experimental forms of survival.

Valparaíso School Rodrigo Pérez de Arce, Fernando Pérez Oyarzún, 2003 The School of Architecture at the Catholic University of Valparaíso, Chile, underwent a transformation in 1952 when a group of young architects led by Alberto Cruz began teaching at the school. The Valparaíso School, as it became known, acquired an international reputation for its radical stance and its commitment to dialogue between architects and other disciplines. From 1970 onwards, it began to focus much of its research and design activity on the Open City project, which had been created by a group of architects, artists and poets with a vision of a city with no master plan, no imposed ordering devices, and no hierarchical networks of infrastructure. Originally set up as a laboratory-type environment, this alternative community has since become a place of residence and work for like-minded people. *Valparaíso School: Open City* Group provides an insight into this radical experiment in urban development through a series of essays and photographs.--BOOK JACKET. Ephemeral Histories Camilo D. Trumper, 2016-07-26 Politics under Salvador Allende was a battle fought in the streets. Everyday attempts to “ganar la calle” allowed a wide range of urban residents to voice potent political opinions. Santiaguinos marched through the streets chanting slogans, seized public squares, and plastered city walls with graffiti, posters, and murals. Urban art might only last a few hours or a day before being torn down or painted over, but such activism allowed a wide range of city dwellers to participate in the national political arena. These popular political strategies were developed under democracy, only to be reimagined under the Pinochet dictatorship. *Ephemeral Histories* places urban conflict at the heart of Chilean history, exploring how marches and protests, posters and murals, documentary film and street photography, became the basis of a new form of political change in Latin America in the late twentieth century.

Modern Architecture in Latin America Luis E. Carranza, Fernando Luiz Lara, 2015-01-05 Designed as a survey and focused on key examples and movements arranged chronologically from 1903 to 2003, this is the first comprehensive history of modern architecture in Latin America in any language. Runner-up, University Co-op Robert W. Hamilton Book Award, 2015 *Modern Architecture in Latin America: Art, Technology, and Utopia* is an introductory text on the issues, polemics, and works that represent the complex processes of political, economic, and cultural modernization in the twentieth century. The number and types of projects varied greatly from country to country, but, as a whole, the region produced a significant body of architecture that has never before been presented in a single volume in any language. *Modern Architecture in Latin America* is the first comprehensive history of this important production. Designed as a survey and focused on key examples/paradigms arranged chronologically from 1903 to 2003, this volume covers a myriad of countries; historical, social, and political conditions; and projects/developments that range from small houses to urban plans to architectural movements. The book is structured so that it can be read in a variety of ways—as a historically developed narrative of modern architecture in Latin America, as a country-specific chronology, or as a treatment of traditions centered on issues of art, technology, or utopia. This structure allows readers to see the development of multiple and parallel branches/historical strands of architecture and, at times, their interconnections across countries. The authors provide a critical evaluation of the movements presented in relationship to their overall goals and architectural transformations.

DesignBuild Joint perspectives Nina Pawlicki, Charlotte Perschmann, Ammon Budde, 2023-11-13 Die von der Sto-Stiftung unterstützte Buchreihe „DesignBuild REFLECT beleuchtet theoriebildende und projektübergreifende Fragestellungen der Lehr- und Lernmethode „DesignBuild“. Als erstes der auf vier Bücher angelegten Reihe ist nun „DesignBuild joint perspectives“ erschienen. In diesem Buch erörtern die Autorinnen und Autoren eine gemeinsame DesignBuild-Hypothese anhand des Spannungsfeldes zwischen gesellschaftlicher Transformation, Architekturausbildung und -produktion. Chilean Modern Architecture Since 1950 Fernando Pérez Oyarzún, Rodrigo Pérez de Arce, Horacio Torrent, 2010 Chilean architecture--along with that of Sao Paolo and Mexico City--sets a benchmark for the intersection of modernism with vernacular influences in Latin America. Culture, landscape, and the geology of this earthquake-prone region have all served as important filters for the practice of post-1950s design in Chile. This volume introduces the modern architecture of Chile to readers in the United States. Looking primarily at domestic architecture as a lens for studying the larger movement, Fernando Perez Oyarzun considers the relationship between theory and practice in Chile. As he shows in his chapter, during the early 1950s the School of Valparaiso offered the possibility of developing experimental projects accompanied by theoretical statements. There, visual artists considered poetry the starting point of modern architecture and contributed their radically modern views to the design process of the project. Next, Rodrigo Perez de Arce examines the material context of architecture in Chile: the availability of materials and technologies, the frequency of violent earthquakes and related seismic activity, and the nation's craft-based, labor-intensive building practices. He applies these considerations to a series of case studies to demonstrate how they interact with cultural, historical, economic, and even political influences. In the book's final chapter, Horacio Torrent reviews the interplay between the architectonic culture and modern shapes that came into sharp focus in the 1950s in Chile. In another series of case studies, he highlights the formation of a system of concepts, thought processes, instruments, and values that have given Chilean architecture a certain singularity during the last fifty years.

Modern Architecture Graham Livesey, 2024-11-15 Modern Architecture: The Basics examines technological, stylistic, socio-political, and cultural changes that have transformed the history of architecture since the late 18th century. Broad definitions of modernity and postmodernity introduce the book, which comprises 24 short thematic chapters looking at the concepts behind the development of modern and postmodern architecture. These include major historical movements, key

figures, and evolving building typologies. There is also an emphasis on the changing city during the 19th and 20th centuries. Approaches to representation and its impacts on architecture are studied, along with the changing global role of architecture as cultural expression. The book introduces new topics, including gender, race, postcolonialism, and indigeneity. An undaunting, contemporary, and inclusive account of modern architectural history, this is a must-read for all students of architecture as well as those outside the discipline approaching the subject for the first time.

Composiciones bajo tierra Gerardo Pulido, 2015 *Composiciones bajo tierra* aborda aspectos clave de la abstracción prehispánica tal como resuenan en diferentes momentos del arte moderno y contemporáneo. De esta manera, los textiles andinos, los atuendos propios de las ceremonias selk'nam, y las líneas de Nasca son abordados a la luz de la enseñanza y obra del artista alemán Josef Albers, la abstracción geométrica de comienzos del siglo XX, y el Land Art norteamericano, respectivamente. La mirada detrás de estos textos no es la del teórico o historiador del arte, sino la del artista visual, por lo que las interpretaciones que encontramos son más arriesgadas, pero también abiertamente tentativas, tal como debiera ser todo ensayo en tanto tal. *Compositions Under the Soil* addresses key aspects in pre-Hispanic abstraction and how they resonate through different periods of Modern and Contemporary Art. Therefore the Andean textiles, the ceremonial Selk'nam attires, and the Nasca Lines are approached in the light of the work and teachings of German artist Josef Albers, the early 20th century Geometric Abstraction, and the North American Land Art correspondingly. The gaze behind these texts is not one of an art theorist or historian, but the one of a visual artist, therefore the interpretations are riskier and openly tentative, as every essay as such be.

Patologías Contemporáneas Francisco Díaz, 2020-07-01 A partir de una serie de psicopatologías (entendidas como lentes a través de las cuales observar un fenómeno), *Patologías Contemporáneas: Ensayos de arquitectura tras la crisis de 2008* es un intento de analizar críticamente diversas facetas de la arquitectura actual eludiendo sus cerrojos retóricos. Al definir un estado hipotético en que la arquitectura se tiende en el diván –como si estuviera aquejada por ciertas perturbaciones psicológicas– no se busca hacer el diagnóstico de una disciplina enferma, sino más bien forzar condiciones mórbidas en las que sea posible apreciar aquellas anomalías o problemas invisibles en su estado de normalidad.

El golpe en Valparaíso Manuel Salazar, Nelson Muñoz, 2024-01-16 Investigación periodística que revela la preparación y las consecuencias del golpe militar en Valparaíso en 1973, analizando el protagonismo de la Armada y de las otras ramas de las fuerzas armadas y de orden en el puerto y en sus alrededores.

Divergencias Ingrid Quintana Guererro, 2025-05-08 Este volumen, por Ingrid Quintana-Guerrero, se suma a un destacado conjunto de publicaciones que revisitan la arquitectura moderna latinoamericana, entre las que se destacan contribuciones de Blackmore (2017), Quintana- Guerrero, López Durán, Scavitt (2018), Piccarolo, Zein, Gyger (2019), Wood

(2020), León, Anagnost (2021) y Del Real (2022). Excepcionalmente, estas obras, en su mayoría escritas por mujeres, se desplazan de las narrativas celebratorias de generaciones precedentes, y exploran críticamente las motivaciones e impactos de la arquitectura al sur de nuestro continente. Mirame a los ojos Alberto Vega Salgado, 2013-08-01 Alberto Vega, el testimonio de su accidente y su vida posterior En 2006, el reconocido actor y profesor de teatro Alberto Vega sufrió un accidente en bicicleta que conmovió al país entero. El diagnóstico fue severo: la caída le provocó una lesión cerebral que lo llevó a perder la capacidad de movimiento y de habla, lo

que se conoce como «síndrome de cautiverio». Sin embargo, Alberto Vega decidió continuar con su vida. Con My Tobii, un equipo computacional que le ayuda a escribir en una pantalla a través del movimiento de sus ojos, pudo comunicarse. Tuvo que superarse a sí mismo, con dificultad y una paciencia infinita, pero logró trabajar de nuevo en teatro, en cine y ahora en las letras. Mirame a los ojos es un verdadero canto a la esperanza y una enseñanza de que todo es posible.

Geografía de las dunas costeras de Chile Consuelo Castro Avaria, 2015 Este libro entrega conocimientos sistemáticos sobre la geografía física y geomorfología de las dunas de Chile, con énfasis en sus funciones naturales y los servicios que aportan a la sociedad. Se explican además los principales usos humanos y las amenazas que las afectan. Tiene un estilo narrativo sintético, en particular en el capítulo de la geografía de las dunas, donde la información se presenta en fichas descriptivas y explicativas, y se incluye abundante material gráfico, fotos y cartografía. El libro se proyecta como un manual de consulta para profesionales, profesores y estudiantes de geografía, ciencias naturales y ambientales, especialistas de los servicios de gestión y ordenación territorial, como también para miembros de organizaciones ambientales y personas interesadas en el tema.

Politics of the Dunes Maxwell Woods, 2020-11-01 Founded in the late 1960s on Chile's Pacific coast, the Open City (la Ciudad Abierta) has become an internationally recognized site of cutting-edge architectural experimentation. Yet with a global reputation as an apolitical collective, little has been discussed about the Open City's relationship with Chilean history and politics.
