El Lazarillo de Tormes Anónimo, 2016-07-20 La vida de Lazarillo de Tormes y de sus fortunas y adversidades (más conocida como El Lazarillo de Tormes) es la primera novela picaresca de la literatura española y una de las más populares de su historia. El Lazarillo de Tormes, publicada en 1554, es un esbozo irónico y despiadado de la sociedad del momento, de la que se muestran sus vicios y actitudes hipócritas, sobre todo las de los clérigos y religiosos. Hay diferentes hipótesis sobre su autoría. Dado el contenido y la tesis de la obra, probablemente el autor fue simpatizante de las ideas erasmistas. La novela estuvo prohibida hasta 1537 y la Inquisición la incluyó dentro del Índice de libros prohibidos. Después se autorizó su publicación con la omisión de los capítulos más críticos (en los que Lázaro se asienta con el fraile de la Merced y el buldero) y la censura de algunos párrafos donde se criticaba al clero con especial dureza. Hasta el siglo XIX no se publicó la versión completa, que ahora presentamos en esta edición. Ambientada en la España del siglo XVI, bajo el reinado de Carlos I de España y V de Alemania, durante el apogeo del imperialismo español iniciado por los Reyes Católicos con la conquista de América, el tema principal de El Lazarillo de Tormes es moral, y supone una crítica feroz al falso sentido del honor y a la hipocresía, que solo sirve a los poderosos mientras que los pobres (representados por Lázaro) pasan hambre y miseria. Uno de los mensajes de la novela es el despertar de Lázaro a la vida real, donde aprende que para progresar hay que aparentar ser virtuoso, pero no serlo. El Lazarillo de Tormes se escribió entre narraciones caballerescas idealizantes y epopeyas pastoriles propias del Renacimiento, por lo que supuso una auténtica ruptura con estos estilos, al contar una epopeya del hambre y la subsistencia a través del ingenio. Su anónimo autor, crea así un nuevo género literario, la novela picaresca, caracterizada por la narración en primera persona, la inclusión del realismo y la visión pesimista y desengañada del mundo.

The Life of Lazarillo de Tormes, 2005-07-28 The beginning of the golden age of Spanish literature and the particular socio-political circumstances of early 16th century Spain made fertile ground for the emergence of the picaresque novel, an early form of the first-person narrative novel relating the adventures of a rogue or lowborn traveler (Spanish picaresque) as he

drifts through the Spanish countryside from one social milieu to another in an effort to survive. Influenced largely by the medieval tradition of the fabliaux and by the early Italian Renaissance, and structured upon a foundation of anecdotes, proverbs, popular beliefs, and folk tales, the picaresque novel becomes a satirical survey of the hypocrisies and corruptions of society. The picaresque novel is exemplified by the prototypical and anonymously written *Lazarillo de Tormes*, published in 1554, in which the poor boy Lázaro describes his services under seven successive lay and clerical masters, each of whom hides a dubious character beneath a mask of hypocrisy. So piercing are its deliberate social criticisms, irreverent wit, anticlerical attitude and string of mischievous misadventures that *Lazarillo* was an entry in the 1559 Index of Prohibited Books. For the modern reader, the choice of characters and the backdrop for *Lazarillo de Tormes* reveal the heart of Spain's national dilemma after the crucial events of the 1520s. This dual-language, annotated critical edition of *Lazarillo de Tormes* presents the complete text of the novel in both English and Spanish. The translation attempts to capture in modern English not only the meaning of the historical text, but also the qualities of its original style.

El autor oculto en la literatura española Maud Le Guellec, 2014-02-13 Los lectores contemporáneos intentan asociar un nombre de autor a cada texto, en una concordancia ideal entre la obra y su creador. Sin embargo, son numerosos los casos de autores que se sustraen a la mirada del lector. La autorialidad no constituye necesariamente el atributo de un sujeto; puede estratificarse involucrando a otros actores de la producción de lo escrito. Las modalidades de presencia del autor también son múltiples: mientras unos tienden a difuminarse mediante el anonimato o el apócrifo, otros se manifiestan. Este libro se propone renunciar al creador como instancia unívoca para considerar los casos límite en que éste se esquivo y definir las relaciones entre el autor y las diferentes figuras que reviste en la obra. Dicha exploración de la ocultación autorial se realiza a partir de textos españoles, desde la Edad Media hasta el siglo XVIII, antes de que el estatuto del autor sea plenamente reconocido.

La Vida Del Lazarillo de Tormes Anónimo, 2018-07-04 LA VIDA DEL LAZARILLO DE TORMES no nace sin la ayuda de precursores italianos, el teatro de Plauto y Terencio y el de la Italia y la España renacentistas configuran su carácter entre cómico, maligno y cínico. La forma autobiográfica se esboza en el Libro de buen amor y en Corbacho. Se forja en oposición al Amadís de Gaula. Echa mano de la tradición popular y la reviste de un carácter social y religioso, con ironía y sarcasmo. La Celestina y los diálogos de Erasmo son dos fuentes indudables en múltiples aspectos. Se trata de una síntesis genial, al tiempo que innovadora, de todo ello, la cual, para mayor perplejidad de los estudiosos y del lector en general, no nos llega

firmada. Los filólogos se han despestañado tratando de buscarle un autor. Una de las primeras atribuciones que se manejaron acerca del posible autor del Lazarillo de Tormes fue la del fraile jerónimo Juan de Ortega, en cuya celda se encontró uno de los ejemplares más antiguos de la obra, aunque ya algunos escritores del siglo XVII habían señalado a Diego Hurtado de Mendoza como el verdadero autor. Otra de las hipótesis consideradas como más verosímiles durante muchos años fue la de que el autor del Lazarillo era el escritor toledano Sebastián de Horozco, debido a las semejanzas entre la prosa de esta obra y la de sus escritos. Lope de Rueda, Pedro de Rhúa, Hernán Núñez de Toledo, Juan y Alfonso de Valdés, Francisco Cervantes de Salazar... fueron otros tantos escritores a los que en un momento u otro los investigadores trataron de atribuir la autoría de Lazarillo de Tormes. Américo Castro sigue la pista de un judío converso. Rosa Navarro la continua, editando la obra con una autoría bien concreta: el converso Alfonso de Valdés. El estudio de estilometría planteado por J. De la Rosa y J. L. Suárez la atribuyen a Francisco de Enzinas. Alfredo Rodríguez López-Vázquez lo confirma. En la actualidad se conocen cuatro ediciones del siglo XVI: las de Burgos, Amberes, Alcalá de Henares y Barcarrota (en esta localidad extremeña próxima a la frontera con Portugal se encontró en 1992, emparedado, un ejemplar de 1554 perfectamente protegido por un lecho de paja, junto a otros 10 libros de la época y un manuscrito, lo que ha dado lugar a numerosas especulaciones).
