Durante aquellas jornadas se abordaron, siempre desde una perspectiva crítica, temas y aspectos diversos; autores y obras relacionados con las vanguardias literarias de Hispanoamérica: orígenes, momento histórico y posteriores transformaciones. Se valoró también su relación con las fuentes europeas, pero destacando, ante todo, las aportaciones originales.

Espadaña y las vanguardias María Isabel Navas Ocaña, 1997 Espadaña y las vanguardias continúa la serie iniciada en 1995 con el estudio sobre Escorial y la Juventud Creadora. La reflexión teórica y crítica de que fue objeto la vanguardia durante los años cuarenta vuelve a ocupar un lugar de primer orden. Por otra parte, el protagonismo de la revista Espadaña en este período es un hecho indiscutible. En ella se dió cita un amplísimo abanico de posibilidades: desde el debate garcilasismo / neorromanticismo, el ensayo de síntesis que supuso la llamada poesía total o las polémicas que abrieron paso a la poesía social. Por eso, su análisis se convierte en una aventura apasionante, que nos pone en el punto de partida para la comprensión de gran parte de nuestra poesía contemporánea.

CONTEMPORÁNEOS GARCÍA GUTIÉRREZ, ROSA, 2018-11-13 Durante la segunda mitad de los años veinte el grupo mexicano Contemporáneos produjo una importante obra narrativa que la crítica ha descuidado y considerado simple testimonio del cajón de sastre de la llamada prosa hispánica de vanguardia. Sin embargo, hay un fondo ideológico subyacente a las novelas de los Contemporáneos que es el que les da sentido, y que tiene que ver con la situación político-cultural del México de los años veinte, clave en la formación y definición de la cultura mexicana y en la delimitación de la tradición

literaria nacional. El intenso nacionalismo de esos años ayudó a conformar determinados prototipos de mexicanidad y expresión literaria y artística nacional, uno de los cuales fue la llamada Novela de la Revolución. Como alternativa a los conceptos de tradición mexicana, revolución y expresión nacional, subyacentes a ese prototipo que se afianzaba con fuerza en la segunda mitad de los veinte, los Contemporáneos escribieron sus novelas que hay que entender en el contexto general de un programa cultural amplio (poesía, teatro, pintura, emprendido por el grupo para frenar el avance de los efectos del nacionalismo sobre la cultura.

Pero el misterio es parte del universo clariceano y hay que partir de él para comprender la especificidad de su obra». Anna Caballé, El País Desde Machado de Assis, la literatura en Brasil ha contado siempre con una fructífera tradición de grandes cronistas entre los que por supuesto no podía faltar el nombre de Clarice Lispector, sin duda la escritora brasileña más influyente del siglo XX. Este volumen, que reúne la totalidad de sus ya legendarias colaboraciones en el Jornal do Brasil —escritas entre 1967 y 1973—, incluye además más de un centenar de textos inéditos publicados en otros diarios y revistas, ofreciéndonos así una panorámica completa de su labor como cronista. En estos textos, Lispector se nos muestra en una doble vertiente: por un lado, como el ama de casa enfrentada a los más prosaicos problemas domésticos —la administración del presupuesto familiar, la sopera que hay que devolver, la mudez crónica del teléfono, la educación de los hijos—; pero, al mismo tiempo, aparece también como una voz honesta y cercana que nos habla sobre el amor y la muerte, sobre el paso del tiempo, las incógnitas del «yo» y la revuelta contra la resignación cotidiana. En definitiva, una Clarice íntima y brillante, capaz de transformar el hecho cotidiano en pura metafísica, en auténtica literatura.
