Advancement in Equine Pain Management Ludovica Chiavaccini, Rachel Anne Reed ,Claudia Spadavecchia,2025-02-17 Despite recent improvements in the perception of equine pain and welfare, the recognition and treatment of pain in horses still lag behind their small animal counterpart. While most clinicians strongly advocate preventing and alleviating pain, it is still debated whether a little discomfort may reduce the risk that the animal will overuse an injured body part, especially in prey animals like horses. In addition, the reluctance to use systemic full mu-opioid receptor agonists still exists due to the concern that opioids may cause excitation, the fear that opioid receptor agonists may decrease gastrointestinal motility, and the conflicting data on the analgesic efficacy of full mu opioids in horses with naturally occurring diseases. Therefore, this special issue will revolve around recent advancements in equine pain understanding, recognition and management. Authors are encouraged to submit papers in the areas of recognizing, preventing, modulating, and managing acute and chronic pain in horses. We also encourage submissions focusing on pain mechanisms, such as mechanistic studies ex vivo or preliminary work involving tissues or biological samples from well-phenotyped horses. Finally, we note significant advancements in the development of therapeutic platforms, viral transfection modalities, or targeted neurotoxins that have been documented on other species and suggest relevance to the equine patient.

VPH has generally a local and regional focus in sample collection. Disease's detection may be limited to

specific areas. Despite this aspect of VPH, the importance of exchanging data, discoveries and information cannot be overlooked due to the everchanging landscape in global trade, transboundary diseases and extended animal movements. On a local scale VPH needs often to face different challenges, starting with the infrastructures for live stocks down to optimization, using new technologies as Artificial Intelligence. There are instances where veterinary services are not readily available and temporary solutions need to be found as for example paraveterinary services. The latter should be guaranteed by adequate professional training along the different stages of, as an example, the food chain production. Given the transboundary nature of zoonotic agents and diseases in the last decades, the One-Health approach has emerged as a new and holistic approach to incorporate the different facets of Veterinary Science. To strengthen this approach, veterinary training should eventually dedicate more attention to public health and to preventive measures of zoonosis and epidemics. This renewed focus will also have the additional benefit of defining more clearly the discipline of VPH. Human Public Health, with the same philosophy, should include the animal ecosphere, emerging diseases and zoonoses, focusing on the 'Human-Animal Interface'.

In vitro and in vivo development of a topical drug for the treatment of equine skin cancer - based on naturally occurring and synthetically modified substances in plane bark Lisa Annabel Weber, 2021-05-25 Equine sarcoids (ES) and equine malignant melanoma (EMM) are among the tumors affecting horses diagnosed most frequently. Both cutaneous neoplasms can be a significant cause of economic losses, morbidity and mortality in the animals. The treatment of equine skin cancer can be challenging and established, evidence-based therapies resulting in sustained tumor regression are rare. The pentacyclic, lupane-type triterpenes betulinic acid (BA) and betulin can be isolated from many botanical sources, predominantly from the bark of white birch and plane trees. In addition to various biological properties, they have gained attention mainly due to their anticancer features. Within the framework of the current PhD project, the compounds BA, BA derivative NVX-207, and betulin derivative betuliny-l-bis-sulfamate were assessed in various in vitro and in vivo studies for their potential as a topical therapy for ES and EMM. In conclusion, the results generated from cell culture experiments, skin permeation assays and studies in the target species are promising. Further advancement of the investigational medicinal products studied herein could lead to an effective topical and marketable, novel drug which helps to relieve suffering and, consequently, improve the welfare of equine skin cancer patients.
