When, however, the report of some bare fact is in question (It rained, It was 9 o'clock, His beard was brown, or It was 8 o'clock,) it does not matter to the narrator, and if he imparts such facts with the introduction, I believe, then he was really uncertain. The matter becomes important only where the issue involves partly-concealed observations, conclusions and judgments. In such cases another factor enters—conceit; what the witness asserts he is fairly certain of just because he asserts it, and all the I believes, Perhapses, and It seemed, are merely insurance against all accidents.
