La Celestina: Lucena y Juan del Encina. Tomo I Govert Westerveld, 2015-11-15 Lucena era hijo de Juan Ramírez de Lucena, embajador de los Reyes Católicos. Gracias a los viajes de su padre Lucena pudo viajar a Italia y Francia y conocer las innovaciones con respecto al ajedrez y al teatro. Nacido en Aragón, fue en sus años de estudiante de leyes en Salamanca cuando conoció a Juan del Encina. Entre ambos se desarrolló una amistad que iba a durar toda la vida. Lucena estaba trabajando en la imprenta de Nebrija en los años 1493-1495, donde le ayudó con ciertos términos para su diccionario de latín de 1495. Al parecer, Lucena intentaba traducir y editar en castellano libros en latín y así vemos aparecer: Mujeres ilustres en romance (1494) Fábulas de Esopo (1495), los libros de Aeneas Silvo Piccolomini (1496), Repetición de amores y Arte de Ajedrez (1497), Vita Beata (1499), El Jardín de nobles doncellas (1500). Poco después iba a dirigir y editar en Italia las nuevas cenas en la obra de Calisto y Melibea con la valiosa ayuda de su gran amigo Juan del Encina.

Tres autores de LA CELESTINA Alonso de Cardona, Juan del Encina y Alonso de Proaza Govert Westerveld, 2014-06-01 Probablemente la idea de escribir La Comedia de Calisto y Melibea vino de Lucena (Juan del Encina) cuando estaban imprimiendo en 1495 en Salamanca su traducción castellana de las comedias de Historia de duobus amantibus y Remedium amoris, escritas por Eneas Silvio Piccolomini Papa Pío II. Juan Ramírez de Lucena estaba en servicio de este Papa y es muy posible que Lucena estuviera en posesión de estos libros en latín y los textos originales de un manuscrito aragonés hecho por Alonso de Cardona, que iban a ser las fuentes para la Comedia de Calisto y Melibea. En 1495 Francesch Vicent publicó en Valencia el primer libro de ajedrez en una imprenta. Juan del Encina (Lucena) se enteró de esto y publicó una copia de este libro, así como la obra Repetición de amores en Salamanca. Como buen amigo, Juan del Encina dio a Antonio de Nebrija las nuevas palabras usadas en el ajedrez moderno y Nebrija las menciona en su nuevo diccionario de 1495.
