*Los límites de la cultura* Alejandro Grimson, 2020-11-10 ¿Cómo entender hoy la convivencia entre culturas, los sentimientos de identidad y pertenencia, la idea de nación? Las teorías posmodernas han firmado el acta de defunción de estos conceptos: han dicho que lo único que existe son diferencias, efectos ilusorios de identidad. Por ello, en estas páginas se trata del fin de los fines anunciados, se postula una reconstrucción del constructivismo y se reponen los sentidos políticos del intervencionismo banalizador. Atento a la heterogeneidad de las sociedades, a los debates políticos y culturales de las últimas décadas, y a los procesos desencadenados por los movimientos sociales, Grimson subraya la necesidad de cambiar las matrices teóricas. Al proponer nuevas miradas sobre la alteridad, la xenofobia, el racismo o los fundamentalismos contemporáneos, redefine una teoría de la cultura. La potencia política de su argumento radica en que apuntala la búsqueda de nuevos acuerdos que impliquen una vida en común y un horizonte socialmente igualitario.

At its heart, the focus is on Cañar, a region marked by more than seven decades of migratory flows to the United States. Cañar features one of the areas of greatest human mobility in the entire Andean Region. Drawing on data from in-depth interviews and dialogue-based workshops with indigenous youths, the author shows how migratory processes and forms of self-representation have challenged the idea that ethnic identity is tied to fixed cultural patterns. He further shows how youths' transnational experiences reconfigure generational differences within indigenous communities. In analyzing how transnational life, adultcentrism, gender power dynamics, and institutional discourses intersect in the production of indigenous youths' subjectivities, this book provides an innovative approach to the studies of indigenous peoples and migration.

First, Corona approaches the problem of difference and heterogeneity epistemologically, asking about the possible benefits of horizontal modes of knowledge production between academics and the social other. She demands reification for those without access to institutions who experience social ills and theorizes a trans-disciplinary dialogue to discover a horizontal construction of knowledge. Zapata evaluates and questions whether indigenous people throughout the continent have had their quality of life improved by the recognition of their collective rights as peoples. These two works provide overviews of a Latin American multiculturalism that connects to parallel movements in North America and Europe. Combined they offer a guide that could be vital to future activism and social work whether in the classroom or on the streets. Critical Interculturality and Horizontal Methodology in Latin America will appeal to scholars and students who are in need of new ways to comprehend the current strain of multiculturalism and plurality. It offers reflections on how social research can be not only sensitive to the epistemologies and interests of the cultural other, but approach parity and horizontality in dialogue.

*Performing Identity in the Era of COVID-19* Lauren O'Mahony, Rahul K. Gairola, Melissa Merchant, Simon Order, 2023-07-31 This innovative volume compels readers to re-think the notions of performance, performing, and (non)performativity in the context of the COVID-19 global pandemic. *Hemispheric Blackness and the Exigencies of Accountability* Jennifer Gomez Menjivar, Hector Nicolas Ramos Flores, 2022-12-20 Hemispheric Blackness and the Exigencies of Accountability examines the way Afrodescendant and Black communities use the land on which they live, the rule of law, and their bodies to assert their historical, ontological, and

physical presence across South, Central, and North America. Their demand for the recognition of ancestral lands, responsive policies, and human rights sheds new light on their permanent yet tenuous presence throughout the region. The authors argue that by deploying a discourse of transcontinental historical continuity, Black communities assert their presence in local, national, and international political spheres. This conceptualization of hemispheric Blackness is the driving force confronting the historical loss, dismissal, and disparagement of Black lives across the Américas.
